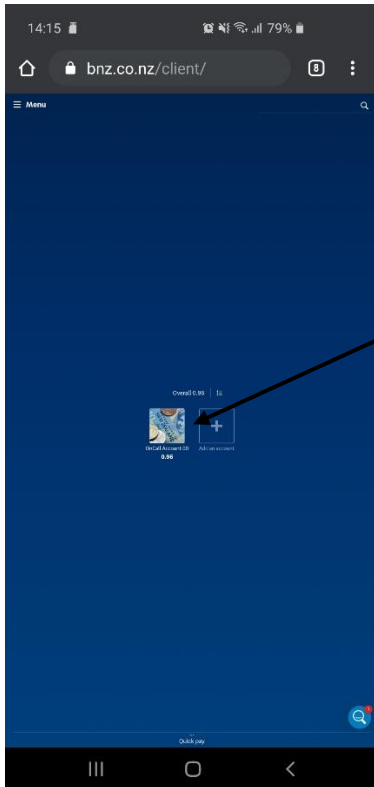


BNZ – How to download Bank Statements into OFX format on an Android phone using Browser Mobile Banking

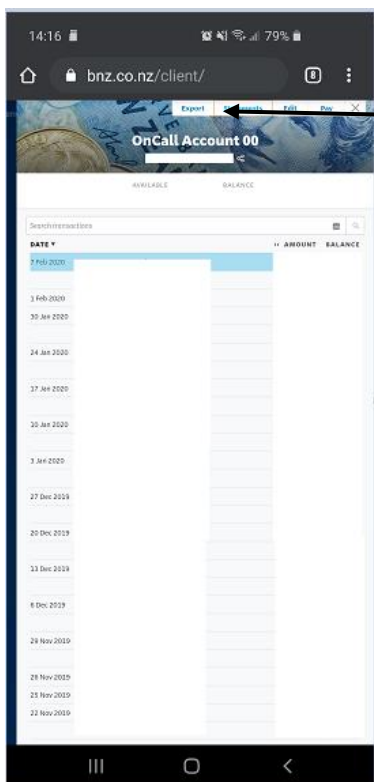
Step 1 – Open your browser and go to BNZs Website – login using your Desktop internet banking details

Step 2 – Click on the account your wages are paid into

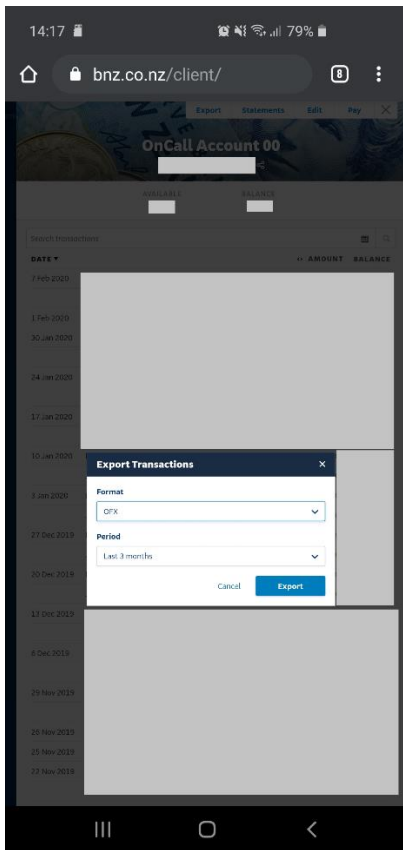
Please note: You will need to repeat these steps to download bank statements if you have more spending/payments in different accounts.



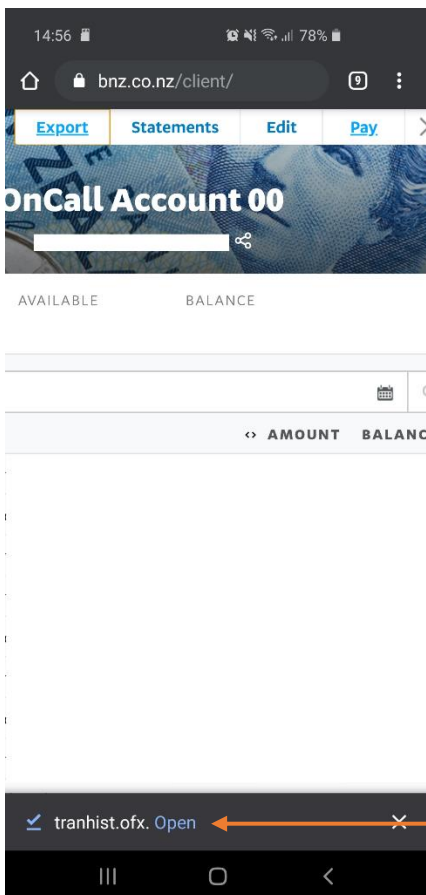
Step 3 – Click on export – if you have a NetGuard set up, at this point you will need to enter in the coordinates required.



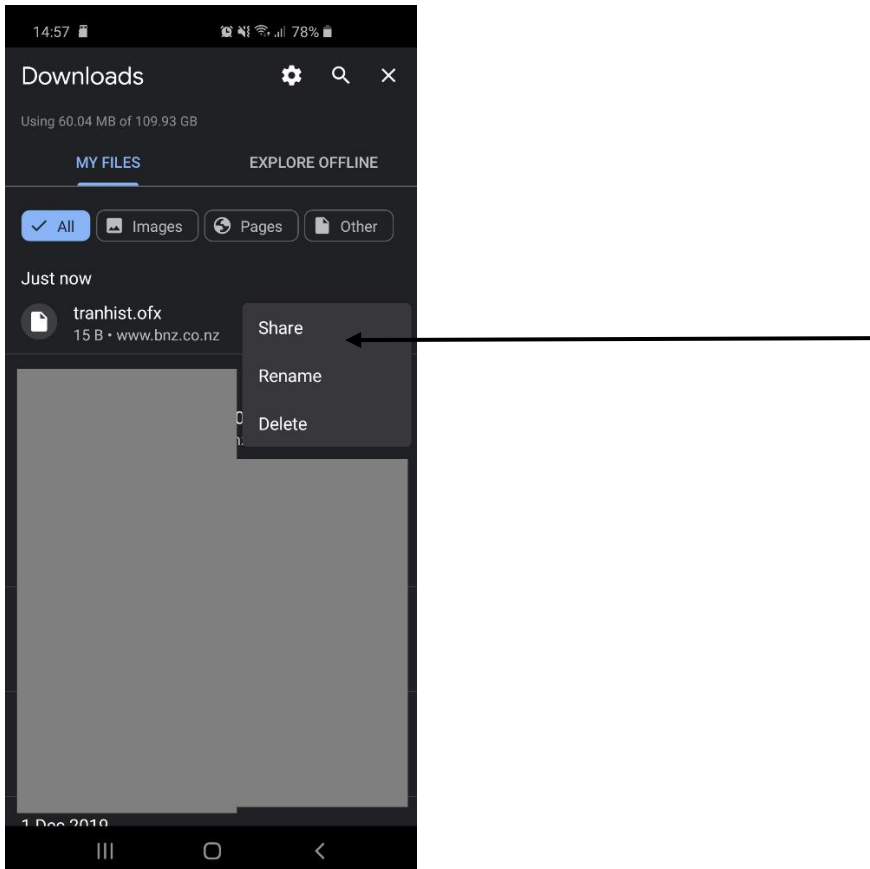
Step 4 – Select the Format “OFX”, then select the Period “last 3 months”. Then click export



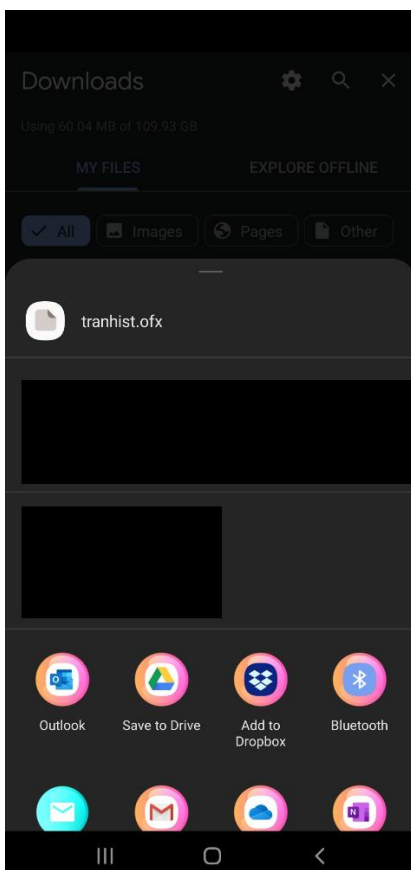
Step 5 – The file will download and appear at the bottom of the screen. Click open



Step 6 - You will be presented with a screen that looks like this. Your file will be the top file. Click the 3 dots on the right of the screen on the file you just downloaded. Click share



Step 7 – Click Outlook (if you don't use Outlook, scroll down to attach to apps such as Gmail, Outlook etc). This will **attach** the file to an email. You can enter the recipient or "To" as loans@savemybacon.co.nz. Click send, and this will send us a copy of your bank statements in the format required.
