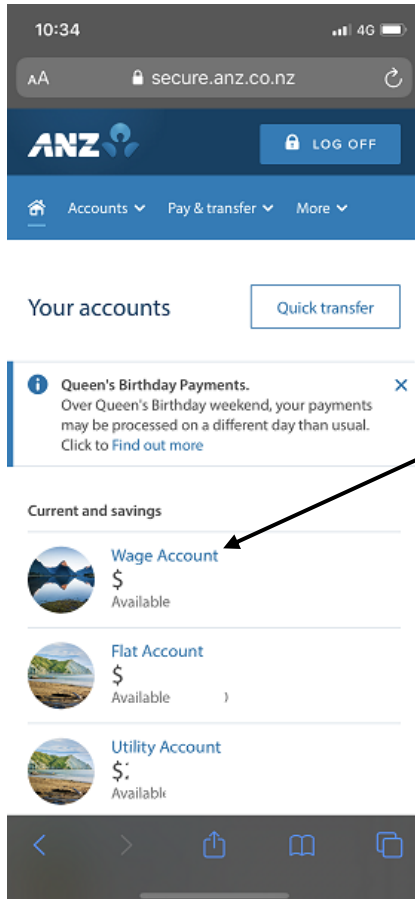


ANZ – How to download Bank Statements into OFX format on an iPhone using Desktop Mobile Banking

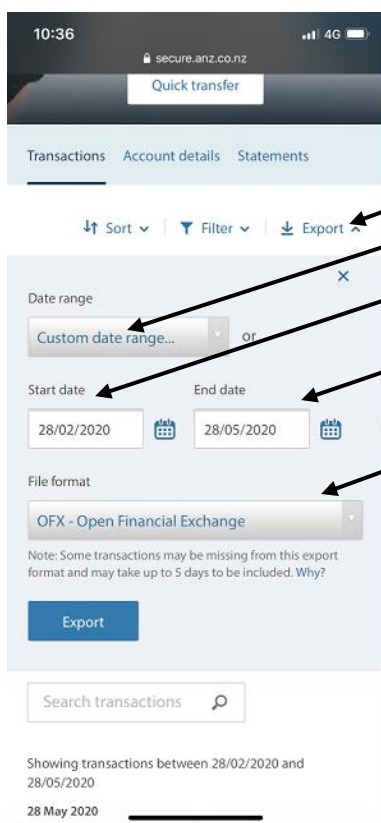
Step 1 – Open Safari and go to ANZs Website – login using your Desktop internet banking details

Step 2 – Click on the account your wages are paid into

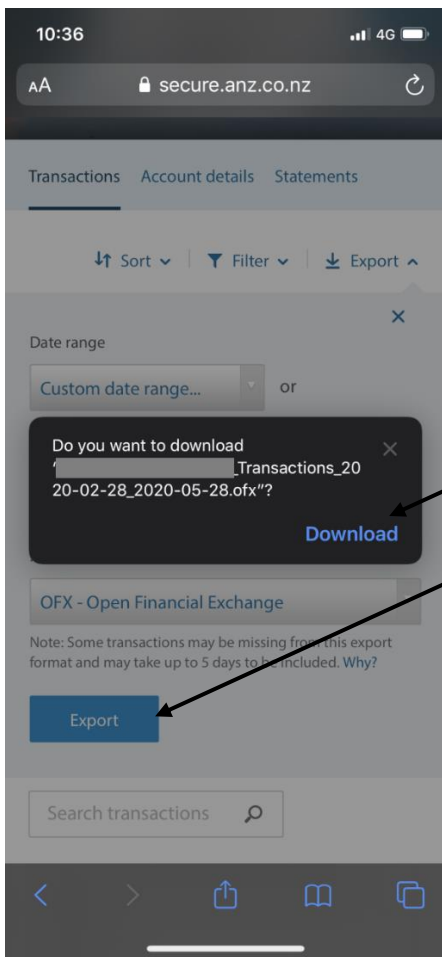
Please note: You will need to repeat these steps to download bank statements if you have more spending/payments in different accounts.



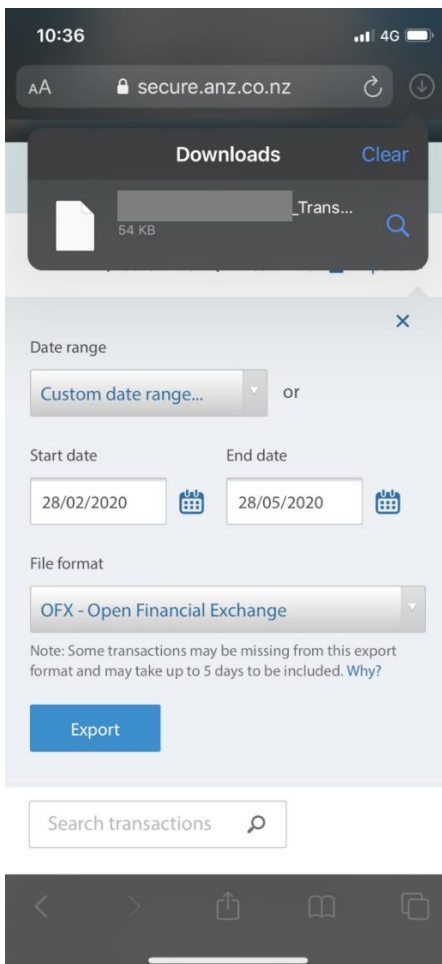
Step 3 – Click on export, click custom date range. Please change the date range to include the last 90 days. Also click OFX as the file format.



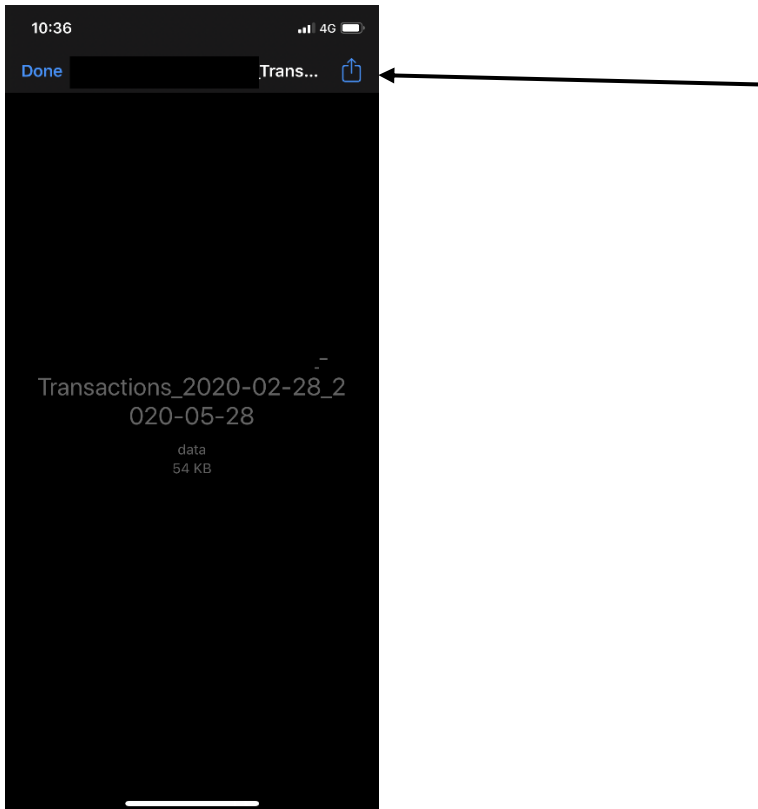
Step 4 – Click export, then a screen like this will appear. Click download



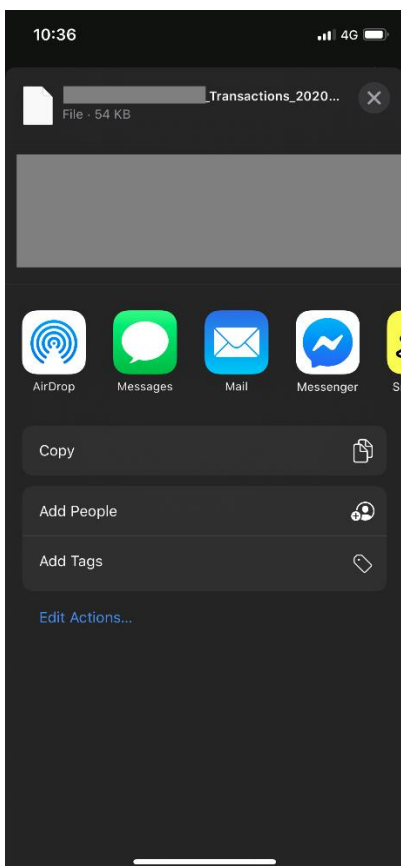
Step 5 – The file will download into the top right hand corner



Step 6 - You will be presented with a screen that looks like this. Click the button on the top right-hand corner



Step 7 – Click Mail (if you don't use Mail, slide across to attach to apps such as Gmail, Outlook etc). This will **attach** the file to an email. You can enter the recipient or "To" as loans@savemybacon.co.nz. Click send, and this will send us a copy of your bank statements in the format required.
